



You have just purchased the <u>BEST PRODUCT</u> on the market in the nail care industry today. This is the latest technology, unlike anything you have used before. To optimize the potential of this product and to maximize your proficiency in using it, we at QNET GLOBAL suggest that you read all instructions carefully. View the Company Training Video.

- 1. There are some very basic rules of application when using Quintessence Nail Care Products.
- Never use Quintessence Nail Care Products near direct or indirect sun light. The sun's UV rays are hundreds of times more intense than our UV light. The sun will start curing the product while you are applying it. Close the shades or curtains prior to use of your product. <u>Never apply product</u> <u>outdoors!</u>
- 3. Always prepare a clean dry surface area to work on. A paper towel will do just fine.
- Use a good light source over your work area to insure good visualization of the application process. <u>Never use Halogen lights</u>, they emit UV light and will start the curing process.
- 5. Use the proper brushes a #4 Sable works for overlays. For French manicures the 1/4 Sable angle cut brush works best.
- 6. The heat and cold parameters for Quintessence Nail Care Products are 40 to 120 degrees Fahrenheit. For optimum viscosity store at 70 degrees.
- 7. You must realize that you are working with a thick viscous liquid, it is constantly moving while in the liquid state. We suggest placing a drop on one nail so you can observe its movement. Watch how it flows, turn it from side to side and upside down. Get used to how it moves, so you can use that movement to your advantage. Let the product do the work for you.
- 8. **Practice, Practice, Practice**. There is a learning curve with any new product. **Remember practice makes perfect.**





QUINTESSENCE NAIL CARE PRODUCT CURE TIME

 <u>FLASHING</u> – A Quick less than **one-second** exposure under the UV light repeated **3 or 4** times, will set the product in place. It will not be fully cured, but it will stop the movement. Use the FLASHING technique to partially cure the product so you can move on to the next nail, without worrying about the product moving on the last nail.

- <u>QUICK CURE</u> A 15-second exposure to UV light. This is used when applying a French Manicure. Quick cure between layers of Hyper-Base Coat and Hyper-French (White) and the Hyper-Base Coat again. This is another time saver.
- 3. **FULL CURE OVERLAY** 1 minute under the UV light in the closed position, for a hard dry, tack free finish.
- <u>FULL CURE COLOR</u> 1½ minutes under a closed UV light will hard cure the Quintessence Colors. This is used for Hyper-French (White) and Hyper-Natural (White). A wide spectrum of Hyper-Colors will be available in the near future.
