



FRENCH WHITE MANICURES

QUINTESSENCE FRENCH WHITE MANICURES

1. Start with the Hyper-Base on the nail first; Cure for only **15 seconds (Quick Cure)**.
2. Use a $\frac{1}{4}$ Angle Cut Brush for best results.
3. Mix your Hyper-French (White) by removing the lid on the bottle. Stir the product with the back end of an applicator swab. This will re-suspend any pigment that has settled over time. Then place a small bead on a post-it, paper plate or tile.
4. Place brush into product, wetting both sides of the brush, do not use too much, a small amount goes a long way. It is better to apply two thin layers of color rather than one thick layer.
5. Paint your Hyper-French (White) in the shape you desire (Crescent or Chevron).
6. Go under the UV light in the down position for **5 seconds** then apply another coat of Hyper-French (White) then cure for another **15 seconds**.
7. Place a bead of Hyper-Base in the center of the nail plate and lightly brush over entire nail plate.
8. Self level and cure the product for **1½ minutes**.
9. Repeat procedure on all 10 nails.

HELPFUL HINT: The $\frac{1}{4}$ Angle Cut Brush can be purchased at any craft, art or beauty supply store.
